

Arlesdene Nursery School and Pre-school - Accessibility Audit and Action Plan - reviewed November 2015

Area	Considerations	Actions to take
General	School has no steps or slopes internally. Main outdoor and canopy areas are flat. Some areas of the grassed garden are bumpy and the paths narrow. The nursery garden has a hill School has two accessible toilets.	Staff member to support as necessary. Consider width of paths in new garden development
Main entrance of school	Wheelchair would fit through main front door. This is automatic to enable wheelchair access Area from entrance lobby to reception area has a door threshold.	Interior door from the lobby to reception area would need to be held open.
Children's Centre and Pre-school entrance	Main door has two handles. The higher one would not be able to be reached by a wheelchair user. This is in place to keep children safe when they are leaving the building.	Staff member to hold door open
Admin office	It would be possible to get a wheelchair into admin office with some adjustment to furniture	Admin office has a sliding window to talk through. Admin staff would come into corridor to talk to person/child.
Headteacher office	It would be possible to get a wheelchair into HT office.	
Nursery classroom	A wheelchair would fit through garden gate, the main door to the classroom and the door to the garden. The door to orange room is wide enough for a wheelchair A ramp is in place to enable access to the garden . Garden requires additional ramps to enable a child in a wheelchair to use some of the equipment Furniture within classroom could be arranged to allow access for a wheelchair. The children's toilets do not have a toilet that can be accessed by wheelchair users	To think how ramps can be incorporated when in the plan for the development of the garden

	There is a disabled toilet fully fitted with facilities for wheelchair access in the reception area. .	The position of the nappy changing unit would need to be adjusted to allow full access.
Pre-School classroom	Main entrance into the room and the door to the garden is wide enough for a wheelchair. Burleigh gate is used in an emergency evacuation, this is wide enough for wheelchair users Furniture within classroom could be arranged to allow access for a wheelchair. The children's toilets do not have a toilet that can be accessed by wheelchair users	There is an accessible toilet fully fitted with facilities for wheelchair access in the entrance area to Pre-school
Staffroom	It would be possible to get a wheelchair into staffroom.	Furniture would need to be rearranged
Person/child with visual difficulties.	Adaptations to layout of classrooms/school areas would be considered when precise details were known.	Would endeavor to meet individual needs.
